

Minutes of the Clayton County Conference Board

February 20th, 2024

The Clayton County Conference Board met on February 20th, 2024 to conduct a Public Hearing of the County Assessors office budget for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2025.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ray Peterson at 8:35 A.M. at the Board of Supervisors office 600 Gunder Road, Elkader, Iowa.

The minutes of the January 23rd, 2024 proposed budget meeting were presented to the members through the mail prior. Motion was made by Josh Pope and seconded by Mike Finnegan to approve the minutes. All were in favor, motion passed.

Ray Peterson asked for any discussion with the published budget. After no discussion a motion was made by Mike Finnegan and seconded by Nioka Schroeder to approve the published budget. Voting was as follows: School Boards, all ayes; Mayors, all ayes; Supervisors, all ayes. All were in favor with two of the units having quorum, motion passed.

ENTRY OF SAID HEARING

Be it remembered on this, the 20th day of February 2024, the County Conference Board of Clayton County, Iowa met in session for the purpose of a hearing on the budget for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2025, as filed with this Board. There was present a quorum as required by law. There upon, the board investigated and determined that notice of time and place of hearings had, according to law and directed by the board, been published on the 7th day of February 2024 in the North Iowa/Clayton County Times-Register, the Monona Outlook, and the Guttenberg Press. Official newspapers published in said county, and that the affidavits of publication thereof, are on file with the County Auditor. Thereafter, and on said day, the estimate was taken up and considered and taxpayers heard for and against said estimate. After proper hearings, the budget was adopted as proposed. The Clerk was thereupon directed to properly certify the budget as adopted and file with the records of their office as required by law.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Josh Pope and seconded by Mike Finnegan. All voted in favor, meeting was adjourned at 8:40 A.M.
