

Minutes of the Clayton County Conference Board

February 25th, 2025

The Clayton County Conference Board met on February 25th, 2025 to conduct a Public Hearing of the County Assessors office budget for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2026.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Doug Reimer at 8:35 A.M. at the Board of Supervisors office 600 Gunder Road, Elkader, Iowa.

The minutes of the February 4th, 2025 proposed budget meeting were presented to the members through the mail prior. Motion was made by Nioka Schroeder, and seconded by Doug Puffett to approve the minutes. All were in favor, motion passed.

Doug Reimer asked for any discussion with the published budget. After no discussion a motion was made by Ray Peterson and seconded by Steve Doepcke to approve the published budget.

Voting was as follows: School Boards, all ayes; Mayors, all ayes; Supervisors, all ayes. All were in favor with two of the units having quorum, motion passed.

ENTRY OF SAID HEARING

Be it remembered on this, the 25th day of February 2025, the County Conference Board of Clayton County, Iowa met in session for the purpose of a hearing on the budget for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2026, as filed with this Board. There was present a quorum as required by law. There upon, the board investigated and determined that notice of time and place of hearings had, according to law and directed by the board, been published on the 12th day of February 2025 in the Clayton County Times-Register, the Guttenberg Press, and the Press Journal. Official newspapers published in said county, and that the affidavits of publication thereof, are on file with the County Auditor. Thereafter, and on said day, the estimate was taken up and considered and taxpayers heard for and against said estimate. After proper hearings, the budget was adopted as proposed. The Clerk was thereupon directed to properly certify the budget as adopted and file with the records of their office as required by law.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Doug Puffett and seconded by Nioka Schroeder. All voted in favor, meeting was adjourned at 8:42 A.M.
